TECHNICALITY DELAYS FINAL TARIFF ACTION

Democrats Seek to Avoid Going on Record on Scientific Non-Partisan Commission.

WHAT MEASURE PROVIDES Repuls Duties of the Payne Act and Provides for Levying Tax on Incomes.

WASHINGTON, May 8.—The final roll call on the tariff bill will not be taken to-day until the Speaker dispenses of a technical point of order against the Republican motion to recommit the bill.

The point of order is designed to avoid putting the Democrats on record on the question of the creation of a scientific non-partisan tariff commission.

The Underwood tariff measure requires the duties of the Payne act to be raised by 10 per cent. for an income tax on all incomes over \$4,000 a year. Corporations and business corporations tax at 10 per cent.

The income tax is expected to raise an annual revenue of \$17,000,000. The average reduction in duties from the Payne law is from 40 to 50 per cent.

The biggest cut has been made in the wool manufactures. The annual revenue of the new tariff bill is \$80,000,000, whereas the revenue from the old tariff bill is estimated at \$85,701,000.

The Underwood bill puts boots and shoes, hosiery, rayon, sugar and the like under a 10 per cent. duty. Red reductions are made in the cotton schedule.

In luxuries the rates have been slightly increased over the level of the Payne bill.

The object of the conference as set out in a statement was to get out the general position of tariff review, as it is presented in the Underwood bill, and to look particularly to the working of the parameters of the bill, to see what changes the President can negotiate trade agreements or mutual concessions with foreign countries.

The manufacturers contend that if the President is given power to negotiate concessions in tariff rate he also is empowered to negotiate increases if they are warranted.

JAP DIPLOMAT TAKES PROTEST TO BRYAN HOME

Ambassador Shatters All Court Customs in Haste to Object to Alien Bill.

SECRETARY SEES WILSON

No Use to Ask Johnson Not to Sign the Measure; He Inform the President.

WASHINGTON, May 8.—Dismaying the customary usages of diplomatic etiquette which provide that representatives of foreign powers shall call upon the Secretary of State at their offices, Ambassador to-day visited Secretary Bryan at the latter's residence, and there presented him a formal protest from Tokyo against the passage of the Webb alien land law in California.

The Secretary for State had been unable to receive the Japanese ambassador before his arrival at his up-town residence the Japanese Ambassador called and asked to see Mr. Bryan.

The representatives of the Washington and the Tadokoro Governments had been gathered together for more than half an hour, and while neither would disclose the nature of the protest, the Japanese protest against the alien land bill had been filed.
