

It is the dollar mark that is causing insurance companies from every section of the Union to rush detectives and largest of gith the payment of \$1,175,000 insurance, most of which was written for Painter a few months before his life was ended.

And it is for this vast sum of money and a desire to perpetuate the good name that the man held in life that his family, his friends and the institutions he had benefited are making a counter fight to prove that the manufacturer, politician, civic leader and churchman did not deliberately lesp into the water to permit them to reap a monetary reward from the treasuries of the organizations which had trusted him.

It will be the mark of the dollar that will be followed in the Goroner's investigation which will begin early this week. It will be this same trail that will be followed when the courts are asked to decide—as they inevitably will—the true story of Painter's death.

Three theories have been advanced in reference to the mystery. The first is that Painter leaped from the ferryboat on which he was traveling from his offlee to his fertilizer factory and refused to be rescued in order that his family might collect his enormous insurance.

The second is that he was attacked by apoplexy and fell overheard in an unceascious condition and was therefore unable to respond to the efforts to save his life.

A third theory—the least considered one—is that the manufacturer had developed a monomania on insurance, and when refused more policies, in a fit of mental abberation decided to end his life.

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Second only in public interest to the dollar struggle in the case is Miss Okle Painter, the manufacturer's daughter, now in command of the entire estate and the chief beneficiary under her father's will. She is a young woman, who has a high place in Jacksonville society, but almost her entire life has been devoted to business. It is because of this that her father's will entrusted her with the care of the fortune.

She was given a business education and for several years has been her father's "right hand man" in his various enterprises. Since his doath she has been in active charge of his tangled affairs. Though palpably unfering from deep grief because of his loss, she keeps regular business hours, attends to all details in a business like way and has shown herself equal to every emergency.

Miss Painter will probably be an important winess before the Coroner's inquiry. The jury has already been impanied and it will at once delve into the mystery of dollars.







road.

The artist's idea is that man can build for himself a mental wall that will keep away the ovil that interferes with him, and enable him to work in peace and develop behind that wall.

And the picture, fanciful as it is, with its demons of gambling, laziness, etc., on the outside, with its good-looking young man cultivating his garden inside, is a truthful picture. Men can protect themselvee with a wall built up of will power and freedom from false ideas, superstitions, bigotry and prejudice.

Man is a mental machine. The devils that live in man's mind interfere with the machine.

You have got inside of your head, that white

You have got inside of your head, that white ivory temple, a brain inherited from thousands of different animals that lived on this earth

of different animals that lived on this earth ahead of you. That wonderfully formed skull from which you look out at the world is simply an expansion and development of the topmost joint in your backbone. In that developed, physical thinking machine lives the soul which is YOU. And it is constantly at war with the attractions, the temptations, the vices, all the troubles that it has inherited from animal ancesty and savage encetry through millions of years. Your gight against evil has got to be a fight carried on inside of your own mind.

The wall that you build around your thinking machinery, around your will, must be a nental walk build up of regular though, of good thought, suppression of evil, and the exercise of

qualities that give results, perseverence, consistency, justice.

Sometimes the building of a wall such as we need is as tedious as was the building of the great Chinese Wall.

The Chinese built that huge wall around their kingdom to keep out the Tarters and other hordes, just as they build the little walls in front of their doors to keep out evil spirits.

Both walls were foolish and useless. For the Tarters came in and ruled in China for centuries, just as the ovil spirits dodge around the little brick walls and go into the Chinese house. Your mental building may be as tiresome and

Your mental building may be as tiresome and alow as the Chinese wall. But, at least, when the wall is built in your mind it will do the work for which it was built.

This season of Spring, of new life on the earth, new possibilities, is the season of hope. It is the good time for the man who has been discouraged, whose years of failure, repeated efforts ending in lack of success, have discouraged him. Lariness, indolence, weakness in mental effort—they are the big trouble.

Idleness makes room for all the other troubles; vices grow where good thoughts are not growing, just as weeds grow when the hos is idle.

Many will look at this picture and think it exaggerated. And many will read this dull editorial, and call it the dreariest, driest kind of a sermon.

But this Sunday newspaper goes into two millions of American families.
