FOSS LEADS FRANK APPEAL.

Ex-Governor Chairman of Massachusetts Delegation to Georgia.

BOSTON, May 27.—Ex-Governor Eugene N. Foss will head the Massachusetts delegation that will appear before the Georgia Prison Commission, in Atlanta, next Monday, to argue for commutation of sentence for Leo M. Frank and present for clemency petitions bearing the signatures of 20,000 persons. The other members of the committee are Dr. J. W. Coughlin of Fall River, a member of the Democratic National Committee; Dr. Ernest H. Gruening, managing editor of The Boston Traveler, and Alexander Brin, also a Boston newspaper man.

It is expected that the committee will leave Boston Saturday.
